Move Colorado's Vision and Mission

Refined to incorporate Key Themes:

Current:

- Vision: To enhance the quality of life for citizens of Colorado through an efficient, connected and sustainable multi-modal transportation system.
- Mission: Advance financial solutions for a Colorado multi-modal transportation system that promotes economic viability and an improved quality of life.



Refined:

- Vision: To maintain and enhance the quality of life for current and future citizens of Colorado through an efficient, connected, resilient, and sustainable multi-modal system.
- Mission: Advocate for sustainable financial solutions, an informed state legislature, and industry collaboration to promote a multi-modal transportation system that is safe, reliable, economically viable and improves quality of life for all Colorado citizens.

Move Colorado's Guiding Principles

GOOD NEWS! Key areas of importance are included in current Policy Principles:

- Colorado's state and local transportation system must be adequately funded.
- Colorado's state and local transportation agencies must use all available tools and partnerships.
- Colorado's transportation system is

- Colorado's transportation system must embrace sustainability, environmental stewardship and resilience.
- Technology is rapidly advancing and will be a key driver in the future of Colorado's transportation system.
